Citation

- 1.** This Order may be cited as the Factories (Safety Training Courses) Order.

Persons to attend safety training courses

- 2.** The occupier of a factory shall ensure that the classes or description of persons employed in the factory set out in the first column of the Schedule attend the safety training courses conducted by the Occupational Safety and Health Training and Promotion Centre or other training institutions approved by the Chief Inspector set out opposite thereto in the second column thereof.

(1)	Construction Workers: any worker employed in manual labour to carry out construction work in building and engineering construction worksites	Construction Safety Orientation Course.
(2)	Manhole Workers: any worker who is carrying out work in manholes or confined spaces in building and engineering construction worksites	Safety Orientation Course (Manhole).
(3)	Manhole Supervisors: any person who is appointed as a manhole supervisor to supervise work carried out in manholes or confined spaces in building and engineering construction worksites	Safety Instruction Course (Manhole).
(4)	Formwork Supervisors: any person who is appointed as a formwork supervisor to supervise the construction, erection, alteration or dismantling of formwork structures in building and engineering construction worksites	Formwork Safety Course for Supervisors.
(5)	Project Managers: any person who is appointed as a project manager to be in charge of all construction activities in building and engineering construction worksites of a contract sum of \$10 million or more	Construction Safety Course for Project Managers.
(6)	Oil and Petrochemical Industry Workers: any worker who is carrying out work in a factory of the oil and petrochemical industry	Oil and Petrochemical Safety Orientation Course for Workers.
(7)	Oil and Petrochemical Industry Supervisors:	Oil and Petrochemical Industry Supervisors

any person who drives or operates a forklift truck in a factory | Forklift Driver's Training Course. |
